is Full Professor of Multilingualism at the University College of Teacher Education Tyrol in Innsbruck/Austria. Her main research focus is on multilingualism on the individual, cognitive and educational level. She combines psycholinguistic, neurolinguistic and neuroscientific methods for investigating learning and processing of multiple languages as well as the teaching of languages and the idea of multilingualism as a resource in the classroom. She has a particular interest in the effects of multilingualism on cognition and in the bilingual advantage debate.

She lived and worked in the UK and in Germany at different universities before being appointed to her current position in Innsbruck.

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
